By leaving a gift in your Will to Guide Dogs Tasmania, you are helping to provide vital services, and the training and placement of life changing Guide, and Assistance Dogs to Tasmanians living with disability.

How to leave a gift in your Will

Step 1. Let your family and loved ones know

This is a personal decision for you to make, but we recommend letting your family know that you are planning to leave a gift to Guide Dogs Tasmania so they are aware of your decision.

Step 2. Decide on the type of gift to leave

There are three main ways to leave a gift in your Will

A specific legacy

You can make a specific gift by stating the dollar amount in your Will.

A residuary bequest

You can make a gift of the residue or a percentage of the residue of your estate once specific gifts and expenses have been take care of.

An asset

You may wish to make a gift of a specific asset, for example real estate, shares or other items of value.

Step 3. Seek advice from a professional solicitor

Your Will is an important legal document and a solicitor can help you ensure that your paperwork is in order and worded correctly. Further information can be found on the reverse side of this information sheet.
